The first three tests consist of multiple choice questions with answers recorded on computer marked answer booklets.

The fourth test is a writing task of twenty minutes duration. The writing will be judged on the quality of thinking about a given topic, the organisation of ideas and the use of language demonstrated in the piece of writing. The test is marked by trained markers using pre-determined criteria. The given stimulus can range from an image to a statement or a question on any topic which is provided for students to produce writing that is their own original work.
